Fall Protection consistently ranks among the top of the most frequently cited workplace hazards and is the subject of a long-anticipated rulemaking that OSHA finalized in November 2016 and that went into effect in January 2017. This webinar will provide an overview of the steps that employers must take to protect workers from slips, trips, and falls and the compliance implications of OSHA's recent rulemaking.
