## TCEQ Issues Oil and Gas General Operating Permits Renewals

On October 19, 2006, TCEQ issued the renewal and revisions of the Oil and Gas Title V General Operating Permits for use by crude petroleum and natural gas, natural gas liquids, natural gas transmission, and natural gas transmission and distribution industry sites that are similar in operation.

On October 5, 2006, TCEQ held an informational meeting in Houston regarding the Houston/Galveston/Brazoria 8-Hour Ozone Nonattainment Area State Implementation Plan (SIP) developments and the upcoming proposal of associated rules.
